## Transnational School of Service Design for a Just Transition




A European training programme for youth workers, civil servants, and educators working with young people.


1 What is this course about?

The Transnational School of Service Design for a Just Transition is part of the Erasmus+ KA2 project YouTransition, aiming to tackle youth under-representation in democratic processes by training youth professionals to design inclusive, participatory, and sustainable services.

This programme offers a unique opportunity to:

- Gain skills in diversity and inclusion, youth
   participation, service design, and Just Transition
- Connect with peers across Europe
- Co-create youth-centred solutions at the local level





2 How is the online training course structured?



The online course includes approximately **24** hours of structured learning, combining self-paced modules, readings, reflective and collaborative activities that will be active **from October 2025 to February 2026.**



#### **Residential Training in**






After completing the online programme, a selection of **24** participants will be invited to take part in the in-person training course in Portugal, scheduled for **9-14 March 2026**.

This immersive learning experience will **bring together participants of the online course from across Europe** to deepen their understanding of service design, co-creation, and Just Transition in practice.

Participants will **collaborate** on real-life challenges, join hands-on design labs, and strengthen their network.

After the residential course they will facilitate **knowledge** sharing with the rest of the **course participants and local workshops**.



- Only participants who complete the online training and show strong engagement and motivation will be eligible to apply.
- Being able to communicate in English is necessary for the participating in the residential course.
- Travel, accommodation, and meals will be covered by the project.



#### We are looking for:

- Youth workers, educators, civil servants, or municipal staff involved in youth work, inclusion, or civic innovation
- People working from with or underrepresented groups
- Individuals interested in Just Transition, climate justice, or democratic innovation
- Motivated to apply new tools and methods to co-design youth services
- Residents of Italy, Portugal, Georgia, France, Greece, or Poland
- Committed to completing the online programme and participate in the local actions

You do not need to speak English fluently to take part in this training. All course materials will be **translated** into the language of each partner country, and national facilitators will support your learning and the group activities.






