

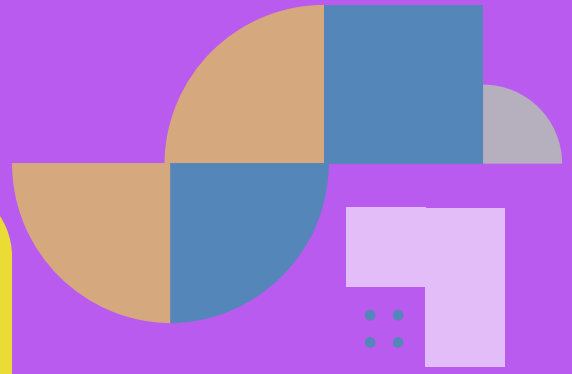




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Transnational School of Service Design for a Just Transition

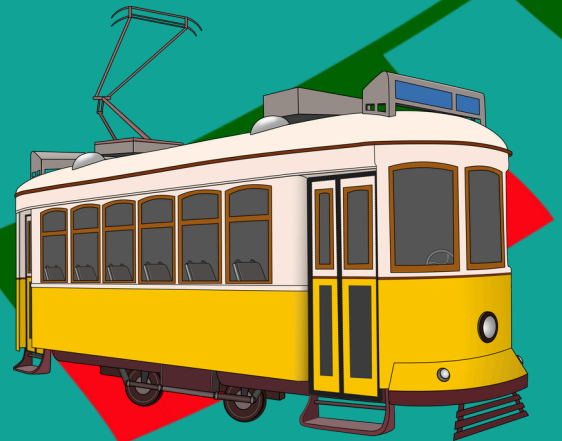
This programme offers a unique opportunity to:

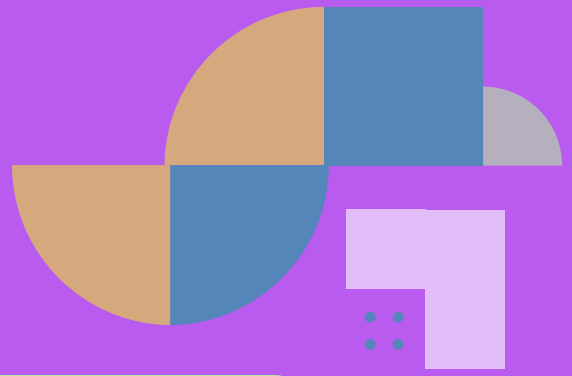

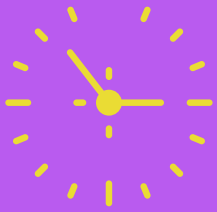

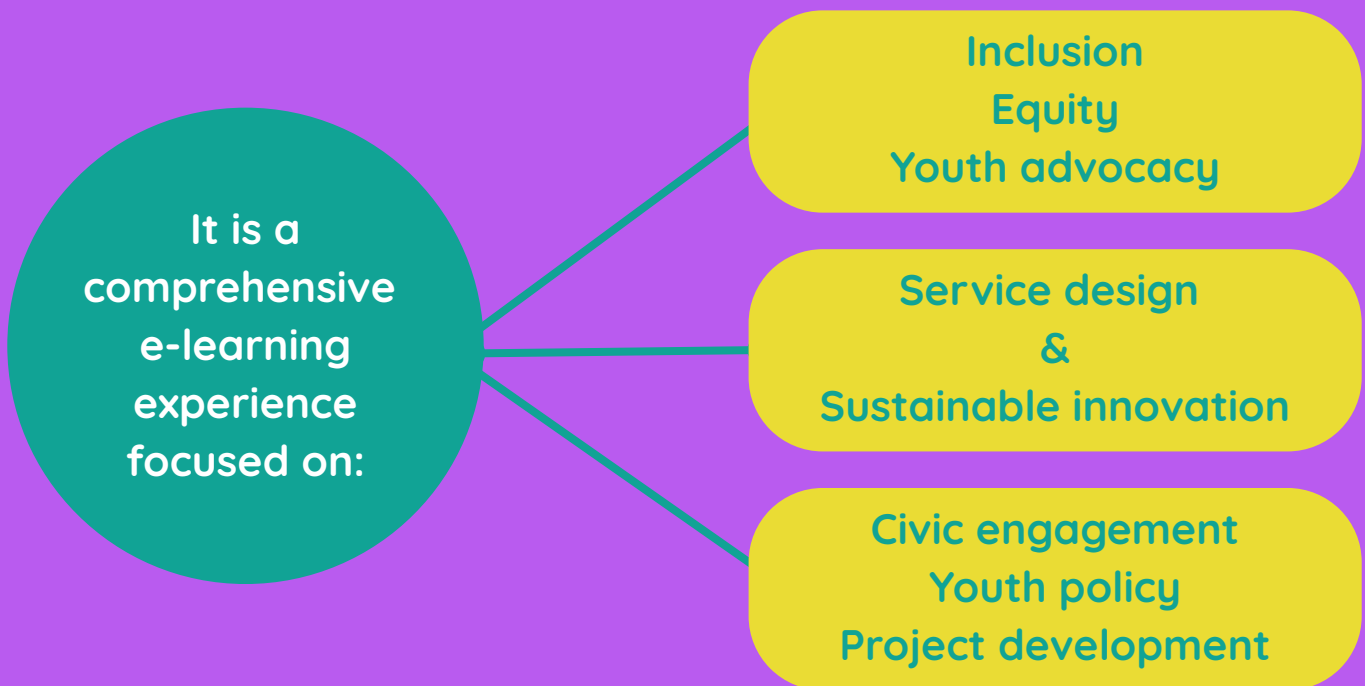
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How is the online training course structured?



The online course includes approximately **24 hours** of structured learning, combining self-paced modules, readings, reflective and collaborative activities that will be active **from October 2025 to February 2026**.

Participants: 80 youth workers from 6 countries

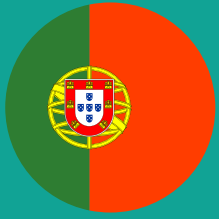

Portugal



After completing the online programme, a selection of **24 participants** will be invited to take part in the **in-person training course in Portugal**, scheduled for **9-14 March 2026**.

This immersive learning experience will **bring together participants of the online course from across Europe** to deepen their understanding of service design, co-creation, and Just Transition in practice.

Participants will **collaborate** on real-life challenges, join hands-on design labs, and strengthen their network.

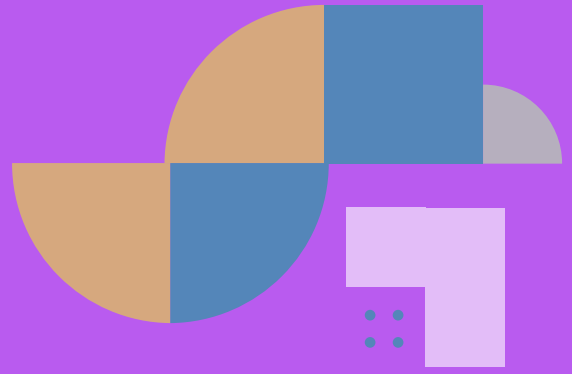
After the residential course they will facilitate **knowledge sharing with the rest of the course participants and local workshops**.

- Only participants who complete the online training and show strong engagement and motivation will be eligible to apply.
- Being able to communicate in English is necessary for the participating in the residential course.
- Travel, accommodation, and meals will be covered by the project.

More information and the call for applications will be shared during the online course.



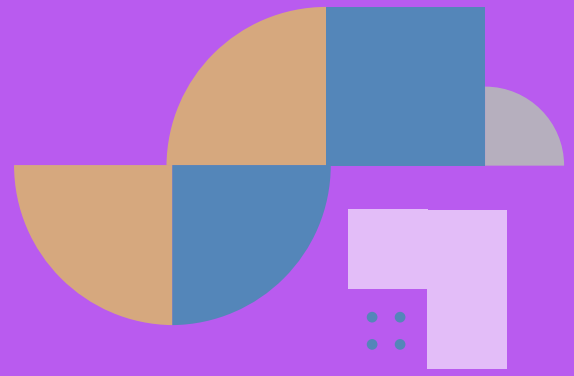
We are looking for:

You do not need to speak English fluently to take part in this training. **All course materials** will be **translated** into the **language of each partner country**, and national facilitators will support your learning and the group activities.

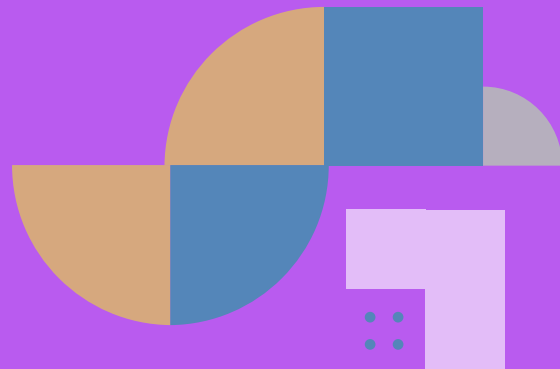
